

### MCBG retreats to Rs377.75

The **SEMDEX** finishes the week in the red territory as it inches down by 0.36 points to close at 2,156.37 (-0.02%) with market value traded (MVT) amounting to Rs20.9m for a total volume traded (TVT) of 0.6m. **Leisure & Hotels: LOTO** rises to Rs6.70 (+0.3%), **NMH** closes lower at Rs10.85 (-2.3%). **GRIT (USD)** drops to USD0.26 (-7.1%).

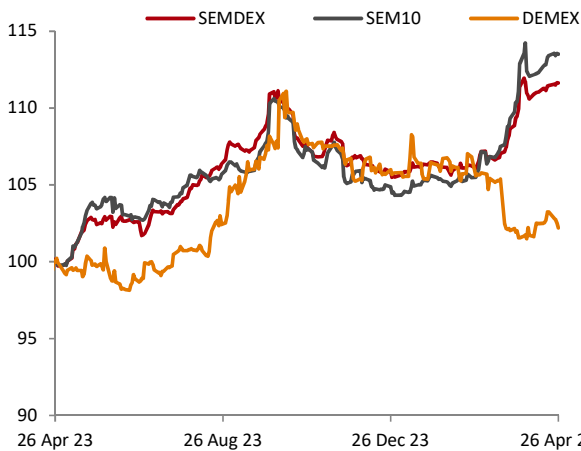
**Foreign Investors (FI)** are net sellers with FI Sellers (FIS) of Rs4.0m compared to FI Purchases (FIP) of Rs3.7m.

**MCBG** retreats to Rs377.75 (-0.1%). Value traded for the day amounts to Rs7.5m, accounting for 36% of MVT. The stock is currently up by 16.6% year-to-date.
