

ENL extends losing streak

ENL continues its downward trend for the sixth straight session, closing at Rs24.00 (-0.4%). The stock remains among the most actively traded of the day and is now down almost 12% from its 52-week high of Rs27.20.

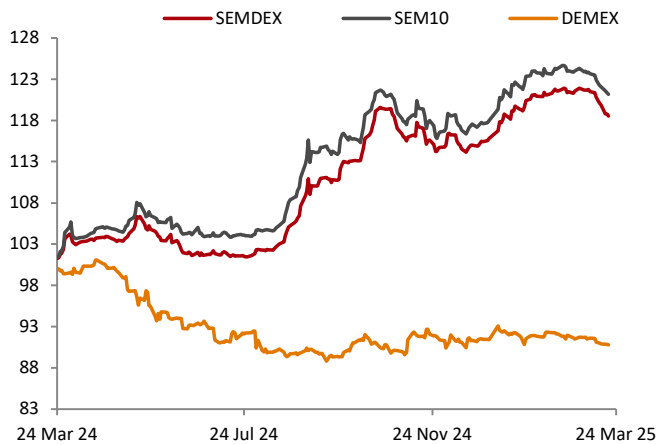
